 - ❑ Status quo plus (donors are told about risk of being ‘found’)
 - ❑ Early identification by consent (towards a ‘bespoke’ arrangement)
 - ❑ Remove anonymity completely, with increased emotional support for all parties
 - ❑ A ‘double track’ system (donor choice - identifiable information available when the child is 18 (the status quo) and being identifiable from the outset)
