TEAMS

MS Teams is a versatile online platform designed to facilitate collaborative working.

Set up a group chat with other students on your course to ask questions and share ideas or resources.



ZOOM

Zoom is a widely used online conferencing tool.

Set up weekly study sessions and ask others studying on your programme if they want to join. Use the time to discuss any problems you're having.

WAKELET

Wakelet enables you to save, share and organise content from across the web.

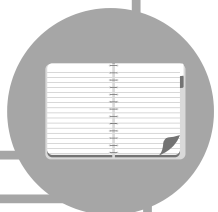
Set up a Wakelet board for your module and share with other students so you can share useful resources.



ONENOTE

OneNote is a digital notebook which can be shared with groups and worked on collaboratively.

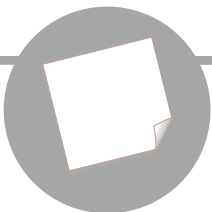
Set up a OneNote and invite others to join. Use it to share notes from lectures or to work together on projects.



PADLET

Padlet allows you to create and share collaborative digital pin boards.

Set up a Padlet board and share the link with classmates. Post questions at any time and share the answers if you know them. Make sure to check anything with your tutor if unsure.



SOCIAL MEDIA

The range of platforms is ever-growing.

Set up a class chat in Whatsapp, or a group in Facebook. Just bear in mind that not everyone on the course might want to create an account.
